Leticia Maher is again inviting you to 'step into her parlour' for an intimate evening of musical delights – as she presents more shows in more locations for the 2011 Adelaide Fringe.

Her successful limited Fringe season last year, capped with a sold out show at Café Komodo, celebrated the French tradition of sharing music with a select group of people in a relaxed setting.

It's been an exciting journey over the past year for the Melbourne singer, songwriter and guitarist, beginning with the release of her acclaimed album **Fallen Angels**. Highlights included an appearance at the St Kilda Festival, a support show for the Black Sorrows in Geelong, Victoria, and a guest appearance on ABC Radio's Coodabeen Champions show.

More recently, Leticia was nominated as a top four finalist as "Victorian Best Female Vocalist" in the Victorian and National Country Music Awards (also a finalist in 2005). Currently touring her album around VIC and SA, Leticia has plans to launch her album in NSW and QLD in 2011.

She returns to the Adelaide Fringe for her third SA tour (dates below) to host five **Sunset Soirées**: two Fridays at **Quality Old Adelaide Inn**, a Saturday session at **The Garage International @ Najjars** and return Sunday engagements at **Café Komodo**.
