In the French tradition of sharing music with a select group of people in a relaxed setting, Leticia Maher invites you to 'step into her parlour' for an intimate Sunday evening of musical delights at Café Komodo.

It's been a whirlwind few months for the Melbourne singer, songwriter and guitarist since the launch last year of her acclaimed album **Fallen Angels**, which is receiving strong community radio airplay around the country. And her 2010 is off to a flying start, following a recent appearance at the St Kilda Festival, beginning her interstate tour to support the album.

She returns to Adelaide as part of her second SA tour (other dates below) to host two **Sunset Soirées at Café Komodo**, 118 Prospect Road, Prospect, on Sunday 28th February and Sunday 7th March - both from 5:00pm.

Kick back and toast the end of a bustling Fringe week – with great music, good company and fine food – and find out why **The Dwarf** said: "Look forward to seeing Leticia live as she's probably one of the hardest working artists in Melbourne. Leticia draws you in. The more you listen, the more you discover... I anticipate great things to come".

Produced by Aria Award winner Craig Pilkington (Killjoys, The Blackeyed Susans, Mick Thomas, The Lucksmiths), and recorded at Audrey Studios with some of Melbourne's most talented musicians, **Fallen Angels** lifts the veil on an award-winning songwriter whose folk-pop songs touch on fado, jazz, blues and country.

Her singing brings to mind the clarity of Eva Cassidy, the intimacy of Bic Runga, cool grooves of Diana Krall and the compassion of Sarah McLachlan. "Felt like heroin, easy to float through like a warm beautiful blue river".

For the tour, Leticia will be backed by ensembles which include Greg Williams (ex-Every's – guitar/backing vocals) and renowned local player Mike Haynes (E-Type Jazz – double bass).
