Melbourne singer Leticia Maher launches **Fallen Angels** in Wagga with RSL and winery shows

Leticia Maher presents an evening and an afternoon musical delights in Wagga Wagga as she launches her NSW tour to support her acclaimed album **Fallen Angels**.

First is the **Wagga RSL Club**, Dobbs St, Wagga Wagga, on Saturday 29 January from 7:00 pm; on Sunday 30 January she is performing at **Cottontails Restaurant & Winery**, 562 Pattersons Road, Wagga Wagga, from 3:00 pm.

It's been an exciting journey over the past year for the Melbourne singer, songwriter and guitarist, beginning with the release of her acclaimed album **Fallen Angels**. Highlights included an appearance at the St Kilda Festival, a support show for the Black Sorrows in Geelong, Victoria, and a guest appearance on ABC Radio's Coodabeen Champions show.

Her next stop after Wagga Wagga is Adelaide, where her successful limited Fringe season in 2010 was capped with a sold out show. This year she is presenting five shows at the 2011 Adelaide Fringe.

More recently, Leticia was nominated as a top four finalist as "Victorian Best Female Vocalist" in the Victorian and National Country Music Awards (also a finalist in 2005). She has been touring her album around VIC and SA, and is launching her album in NSW and QLD in 2011.
