Leticia Maher and her trio present a delicious Saturday evening of musical treats as she returns to the Barossa Valley by popular demand to host a special Twilight Concert 'on the green' at Whistler Wines.

Last year, the winery show attracted more than 200 people from all over the Barossa. And following her successful limited Fringe season in 2010, capped with a sold out show, she is presenting five shows at the 2011 Adelaide Fringe.

It's been an exciting journey over the past year for the Melbourne singer, songwriter and guitarist, beginning with the release of her acclaimed album **Fallen Angels**. Highlights included an appearance at the St Kilda Festival, a support show for the Black Sorrows in Geelong, Victoria, and a guest appearance on ABC Radio's Coodabeen Champions show.

More recently, Leticia was nominated as a top four finalist as "Victorian Best Female Vocalist" in the Victorian and National Country Music Awards (also a finalist in 2005). Currently touring her album around VIC and SA, Leticia has plans to launch her album in NSW and QLD in 2011.

Leticia is returning this year as part of her third SA tour (other dates below) to host the **Whistler Wines Twilight Concert**, Seppeltsfield Road, Marananga, on **Saturday 19th February at 6:00pm**.
